3. Contact friends and relatives in other districts whose representatives do not support your views. Encourage your friends or relatives to contact their representatives urging them to reunite families and create a just and humane immigration policy.
4. VOTE, always!
5. Support candidates who favor wise immigration policies that uphold our country's values and your personal moral convictions.
6. Get to know immigrant families or individuals. Listen to their stories. Share your story with them. Encourage your children to make friends with children from other countries and backgrounds.
7. Support businesses owned by immigrants.
8. Continue to stay abreast of issues involving immigrant communities through reading the paper, watching the news, and joining organizations dedicated to supporting immigrants' rights.
9. Volunteer your time, treasure or talent to support organizations working with immigrants.
10. Hug your family very tightly - be grateful for their presence.
